### **Conference proceedings**

The conference outcome and results are to be presented in the conference proceedings with an assigned ISBN. Contribution formatting – see the Guidelines for authors. Only the conference contributions prepared according to the provided paper template document will be accepted. Presenters are required to write their contributions in Czech, Slovak or English. The conference proceedings will be submitted to a peer review process before its publication on the conference website. They will also be submitted for evaluation so they can be listed in one of the citation indexes.
